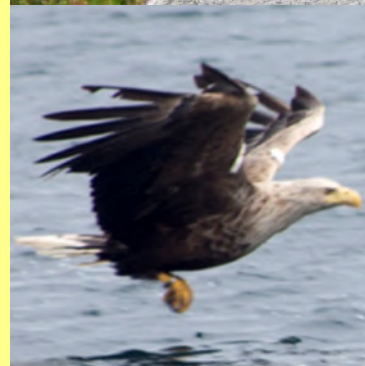


# ALL THE OUTER HEBRIDES & SKYE

### Birding Areas & Highlights

Come and enjoy one of the most wonderful places in Britain. A remote region of wild heather-clad mountains, peat bogs, shallow sea lochs, empty white beaches & rugged limestone, fertile grassland & the famous *machair*. It's just Magical!

**The ferry crossings:** Offering Manx Shearwater, Gannet, Fulmar & Storm-petrel, Arctic Tern, Guillemots, Puffins & Razorbills, with perhaps Short-beaked Dolphins or even a Minke Whale.

**Lewis:** Visiting the Calanish Standing Stones & Carloway Broch, coupled with wonderful wild and remote scenery.

**Harris & Scalpay:** Golden Eagle, Great Northern Diver, Red-breasted Merganser, Hebridean Wren & Twite, beautiful “machair” with Northern & Early Marsh, Heath Spotted & Lesser Butterfly Orchids to name just a few of the wild flowers!

**Berneray, The Uists, Benbecula & Eriskay:** Eider Duck, Red-throated Diver, Whooper Swan, Corncrake, Red-necked Phalarope, Golden Plover, Dunlin & Curlew, Short-eared Owl & Hen Harrier. Plus superb exclusive “White-tailed Eagle Cruise”. Also Red Deer, Otter & endemic Eriskay Ponies.

**Barra & Vatersay:** Further beautiful coloured machair, Frog Orchids, Otter & Eagles, with more fabulous Hebridean scenery.

**Skye:** Driving beside the iconic Red & Black Cuillin Mountains.

Terrific Hotels, excellent food, stunning scenery & we believe worth every penny. It really does all add up to “*Hebridean Magic*”!

### Accommodation & Itinerary

Depart Inverness after breakfast and drive north to Ullapool to take ferry across the Minch to Stornaway and transfer via the Carloway Broch & Calanish Standing Stones to *Scarista House on Harris* for 3 nights stay. A small elegant Grade B listed building offering fabulous food with stunning views over a 3-mile beach which overlooks Taransay. It's definitely one of the most beautiful places in Britain!

Then ferry crossing from Harris to Berneray and drive to *Langass Lodge*, North Uist for further 4 night stay. Another delightful small, privately-run hotel set on the edge of Loch Eport and offering the best food throughout all the Uists.

Ferry from Lochmaddy to Uig, driving through Skye alongside the famous red & black Cuillins, and over the ‘Bridge’ for early evening arrival back to Inverness.
